2009 marked our ninth anniversary of producing wonderful, live, family entertainment here in Kitsap County. If we continue to produce only two shows per year we will have to start turning kids away. Our cast list is growing by leaps and bounds. It is our policy that everyone who auditions makes it into our shows. Each kid deserves a chance. KCMT is enriching the lives of the youth in our community. So, onward and upward! We need to expand.

The North Kitsap Auditorium is booked year round and KCMT barely gets a chance to squeeze in twice a year. Our current rehearsal hall is overflowing. It is quite clear that North Kitsap desperately need a state-of-the-art Center for the Performing Arts. There are many theater groups in this area who need a proper performance venue. There are also dance troupes, music association recitals and touring Broadway-type companies who would all benefit from a performance hall in North Kitsap County. A theatre of this capacity will bless and enrich our community now and for generations to come.

We need an 800 seat auditorium and a 400 seat recital hall. These auditoriums need a shared lobby and courtyard as well as set workshops, greenrooms and rehearsal halls. Our community is worthy of a healthy vision. We have our eye on a piece of property up near Olympic College. In time, we hope to build a school for the performing arts.

Our Board is working hard to fulfill this vision. We are hoping to build in stages. We want you, our KCMT audience, to know that we are all in this together. We keep our participation and ticket prices as low as possible to provide affordable family entertainment. All of us here at KCMT are volunteers. We function with over 50 volunteer staff members. We all keep coming back because KCMT is a fun, family place to be. Our audience keeps coming back because the kids are great!

Building a KCMT Theatre will give our kids, and our community, the opportunity to grow to their fullest potential. Broadcasting is key in getting the support we need to make this dream come true. So, please, start talking!
